Concord Christian School will be adding a unique academic program for 4 year old students. We will offer a preschool program using the A Beka - K4 curriculum. The program will include all day care starting at 7:15 a.m. and go until 5:30 p.m., five days a week. The academic portion will be offered each day from 8:30 a.m. and go until noon, then the afternoon session will offer structured daycare.

The program will be limited to 19 students and have both a lead and an assistant teacher. This program will prepare students well for entering the K5 program the following year. We will start taking enrollment on December 4, 2006. If you have any questions please call 573-634-3983.
